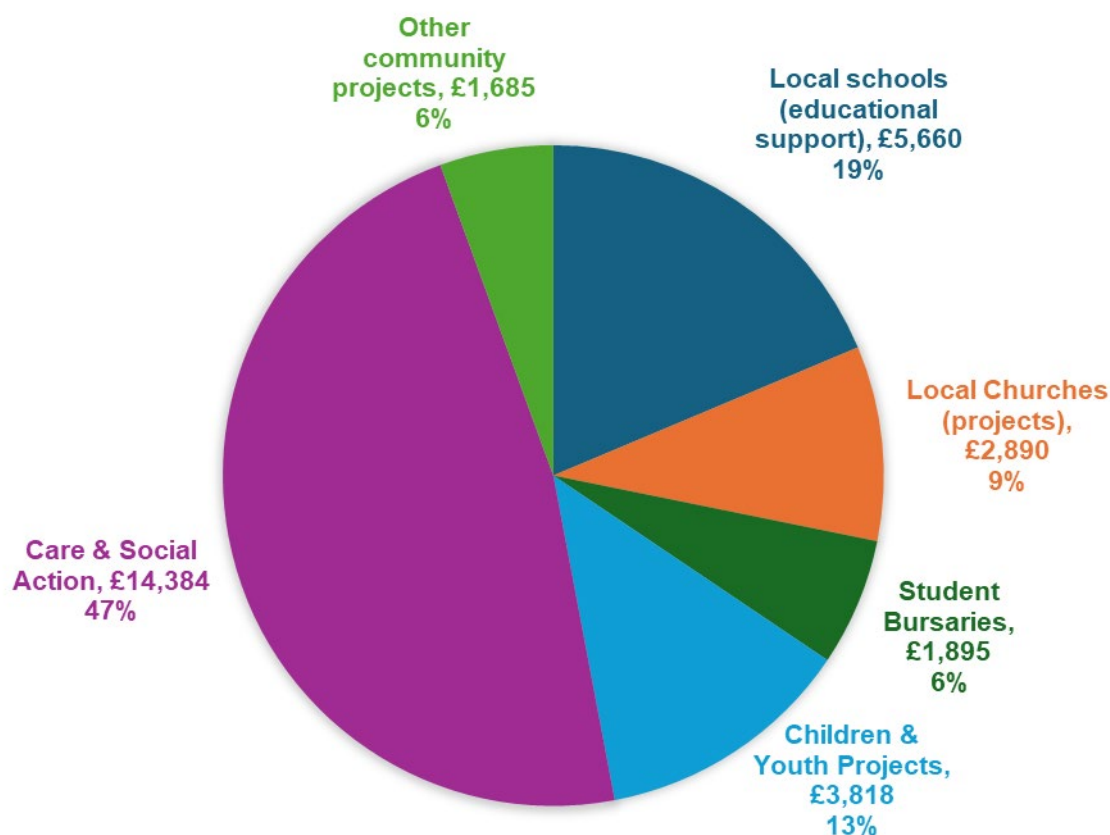


## Donations to charity and special projects
